Shares of stock are available for purchase in the office. Possession of one of these documents qualifies a membership (couple or single) one vote at the annual meeting. Only one share is allowed per membership.

Along with General Manager Ken W, the officers listed above are the members of Star Ranch responsible for running the business of the corporation and maintaining the grounds. We are where the buck stops.




